Baseball

The Baseball team finished the season in a tie for 3rd place. They qualified for the playoffs but ended up losing to Corona Del Mar in the 1st round. Swimming

The 2012 swim season provided another year of league champions, broken school records, CIF qualifiers, and fantastic swims. The varsity girls were led by freshman Lorien Orpelli. Lorien finished fourth in the 100 breaststroke and was a bronze medalist in the 50 freestyle at the Pioneer League finals. Tammy Katz and Celeste Bean made finals in all of their events at the league meet. Seniors Jenny Partida and Emily Grubman made finals at the League meet in all of their events. The varsity boys finished in second place overall at the Pioneer League meet. Senior Zak Zukoski was league champion in the 50 freestyle and took the silver medal in the 100 freestyle. Junior Steven Turnbull took the gold and broke the school record in the 100 butterfly and captured the silver in the 500 freestyle. Sophomore Alexander Ayzenberg took home the gold in the 100 backstroke and fourth place in the 200 individual medley. The Beverly 200 Medley Relay team and 200 Freestyle Relay team were both Pioneer League champions and made finals at CIF.

<u>Boys Tennis</u>

Our Boys tennis team finished 2nd in the Ocean League this year with two very close loses to CIF finalist Santa Monica. The team reached the 2nd round of CIF playoffs losing to Chadwick on the road, 12-6.

At the individual tournament, Drew Freeman qualified for sectionals by reaching the Ocean league singles finals losing to the number one player from Santa Monica. We're looking forward to next year as all but one player is returning to next year's team.

Track and Field

The boy's varsity and boys' frosh-soph won the team league championship, while the girls' frosh soph took 2nd and the girls' varsity finished in third place. The girls' varsity distance team took 8 of 9 of the top 3 places in the distance events. The boys took 17th place as a team. The boys' varsity had 7 league

champions and 14 CIF qualifications. The girls' varsity had 4 league champions and 12 CIF qualifications. Both the boys and girls frosh soph each had 5 league champions. Alexander Rohani won the 400 meters at State, the 400m in league, CIF SS Division 3 Finals and the CIF SS Masters Meet. Brianna Simmons was All League in the 1600 and 3200 meters. She took 3rd in the 3200 meters and 5th in the 1600 meters at the CIF SS Division 3 Finals and was 7th at the State Finals. Sydney Segal won three league titles, took 4th in the 3200 meters and 7th in the 1600 meters at the CIF SS Division 3 Finals. Chanan Batra won league in both the 800 meters and 1600 meters and took 8th place in the CIF SS Division 3 Finals. Amanda Christovich won league in both the 800 meters and 1600 meters. Austin Greer won the froshsoph boys league titles in the shot put and discus; while Dominic Perlman ran away with the boy's frosh soph title in the 800 meters.

Boys Volleyball
