BHAAA Donates Scoreboard For Nickoll Field

President of the Beverly Hills Athletic Alumni Association Steven Fenton thanked several sponsors at Tuesday's Board of Education meeting for its generous sponsorship of the first scoreboard in Beverly Hills High School history to be used for multiple sports.

The scoreboard was donated by the Beverly Hills Athletic Alumni Association in conjunction with sponsorships by *The Courier*, The Beverly Hills Police Officers Association, The Beverly Hills Firemen's Association and the Bosse Family through a generous PTSA donation. The BHAAA also donated a second scoreboard for the Swim Gym at the high school.

The Beverly Hills Athletic Alumni Association was organized in 2006 by 75 former Beverly athletes for the sole purpose of raising funds for the athletic department at Beverly Hills High School. The organization is part of the Beverly Hills Education Foundation but has its own Board of Directors and to date has donated close to \$52,000 to the athletic department for a number of sports.

"Our athletic facilities are in deplorable condition," Fenton said. "With the support of the community on projects such as this scoreboard, we can return these facilities to the grandeur they once were. However, we need everyone's participation and I hope that the community will come support our organization on Sept. 30 and assist us in reaching
